HOSTING ORGANISATION
Please give a short description of hosting organisation (and, if applicable, of local coordinating organisation)
The coordinating organisation (ADICE) is a non-profit association, created in February 1999 according to the 1901 Law. We are operating in Roubaix, a town in the North of France with a particularly large part of immigrated population (more than 50%, in majority from North Africa) and a very high rate of unemployment, especially for young people with foreign origins.  Our aim in this context is mainly to fight discrimination and to favour the social promotion of the most vulnerable publics (young people, women, unemployed, immigrated persons) by supporting their participation in European mobility programmes. We consider mobility to foreign countries as an experience which gives the possibility to develop diver's personal and professional skills: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· social skills ( solidarity, self confidence, open-minded, autonomy, criticism spirit) so that they are more able to take part in the decision making process</li> <li>· professional skills: usually they work as volunteers or trainees on a specific activity where they get skills ( team work, technical skills)</li> <li>· intercultural learning, which means that they get to know another culture, accept the differences, get rid of stereotypes and share it when back home</li> </ul> Moreover being involved abroad give to youth we are working with a concrete experience of cultural diversity which characterizes European Union.

**Lille** is a city in northern [France](#). It is the principal city of the [Lille Métropole](#), the fourth-largest [metropolitan area](#) in the country behind those of [Paris](#), [Lyon](#) and [Marseille](#). Lille is situated on the [Deûle](#) River, near France's border with [Belgium](#). It is the [capital](#) of the [Nord-Pas de Calais region](#) and the [prefecture](#) of the [Nord department](#).

The city of Lille, which annexed [Lomme](#) on 27 February 2000, had a population of 226,014 at the 2006 census<sup>[1]</sup>. Meanwhile, the Lille Métropole, which also includes [Roubaix](#), [Tourcoing](#) and numerous suburban communities, had a population of 1,091,438. The [eurodistrict](#) of Lille-Kortrijk, which also includes the areas of the Belgian cities of [Kortrijk](#), [Tournai](#), [Mouscron](#) and [Ypres](#), had 1,905,000

France's fourth largest metropolitan area, an international crossroads and a dynamic financial centre, Lille is also an artistic and historic city. In 2004, it was designated as a European Culture Capital. Since then, Lille has become an important tourist destination, recognised for its welcoming living environment, well-preserved heritage and active cultural life.
