

## Freiwillige gesucht!

Die VILLA Leipzig sucht Interessenten (zwischen 18-30 Jahren) für ein spannendes Projekt im Rahmen eines Europäischen Freiwilligendienstes in Helsingborg / Schweden.

### Projektbeschreibung / Aufgabenbereiche

The topic of the EVS is to get a very good insight in how a municipality in Sweden work with young adults who are unemployed. Reasons for this are many. We want to contribute with as much input as possible of how we work with young adults out of different perspectives. The main activity will be at Kompetenscenter Norrehed in the municipality of Helsingborg.

We work with approximately 60 young adults every day in a method, free translation, "Coach to knowledge of employment". The volunteer will have full access of how we work and also the possibility to themselves be coached in the matter of employment and happenings in life, how to deal with different issues that stands in the way of employment, not as a therapeutic conversation but more in general. The volunteer will work side by side with a coach when working with our youngsters. Depending on willingness, matureness, courage, etc. the volunteer will be encouraged to plan a day or half a day of content for our target group.

Other activities are:

- Visit several organizations both within the municipality and governmental organizations as well as nonprofit organizations in the region of Skåne, south Sweden.
- Get a Swedish language course, to managing Swedish in order to get around on their own.
- Partake in the preparations for the new volunteers
- Visiting the Hassela movement, a project financed via the European Social fond (ESF).
- Trips to other municipalities working with young adults.
- Practice or field study in a Swedish gymnasium or ground school.
- Work with our Facebook or Blog.
- Visiting IFALL in Örkelljunga that works with integration
- Practice at UNGSAM, they work with drop-outs and NEETs, on Kompetenscenter Norrehed
- 4 days at SMART VÄG, a FINSAM financed project for Youngsters in the age of 16-20, promoting EVS and Youth Exchange.
- Visit to our NA in Stockholm
- Visit Europa Direkt in Helsingborg.
- Field trip to Denmark Jobcenter in Helsingör to get an idea how they work in Denmark with unemployment. In south Sweden we have close connections with job opportunities in Denmark.
- Visit Arbetsförmedlingen what happens when you get unemployed, what steps do you have to take.
- Blå Kamelen and RFSU, how do we work with young people regarding sex related issues, pregnancy, birth controls etc.
- KRAMI ex criminal young adults, how do KRAMI work with them.
- Maria Nordväst, drug related issues for young people.
- NAJADEN psychological issues regarding youngsters, how the healthcare system works.
